Enrollment Process

Phase 1: Submission of Application Form.

The process starts once a completed application has been submitted to the registrar with the following documents:

A photocopy of identity card, passport or an Individual Civil Registry Record.
An original Family Civil Registry Record.
A transcript of previous and/or current academic record.
A copy of the therapist(s) report where applicable.
A non-refundable application fee.

Phase 2: Placement Assessment

The registrar will set a date for the placement evaluation which usually takes between 2 to 3 hours depending on the grade level. For grade 6 and above, a math outline will be shared prior to the assessment date. Moreover, the principal will have an individual meeting with the student on the same day.

Phase 3: Academic Committee Deliberation

The academic committee, including the teachers who administered the assessment, will discuss the student's performance with the school principal to provide their feedback to the registrar within 72 hours of the evaluation date.

Therapists are included in the deliberation should the candidate have any learning difficulties that should be addressed.

Phase 4: Decision Communication

- 1. An email will be sent by the registrar to inform the parents of the decision.
- 2. Another meeting will be held with the principal, where necessary.
- 3. Upon acceptance, a post-registration package must be completed and signed along with the student handbook.



- 4. A non-refundable registration and development fund fees should be settled upon acceptance within the deadline provided.
- 5. Completion of the registration file by submitting the remaining documents during the first week of September:

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- ☐ A certified statement from the MEHE indicating his/her previous academic year.
- ☐ A copy of the applicant's Official Health Record.
- ☐ An original Individual Civil Registry Record, not older than 3 months.

Tuition Fees

A separate document will be shared upon acceptance detailing the tuition fees per grade level.

General Admission Policy:

Goodwill International School (GIS) welcomes students from all backgrounds, irrespective of race, religion, nationality, or political affiliation. Admission is determined by academic qualifications, language proficiency, and seat availability, with particular emphasis on Math, English, and Arabic (especially for the Lebanese Program). The final selection of applicants is made by the school's Admission Committee. GIS does not have the necessary resources to support students with significant learning or physical disabilities.

Academic Requirements:

- Pre-School Applicants: Admission is based solely on a qualifying interview.
- **Elementary, Middle, and Secondary School Applicants:** Selection is based on performance in the GIS Entrance Examinations, prior academic records, and school recommendations.

Age Requirements:

Applicants must meet the following age criteria by December 31:

KG1: Three years old

KG2: Four years old

KG3: Five years old

All students who wish to join the International Program will need to obtain an exemption from Arabic (إعفاء من اللغة العربية المقررة) from the Lebanese Ministry of Education and permission from the Equivalence Committee.
